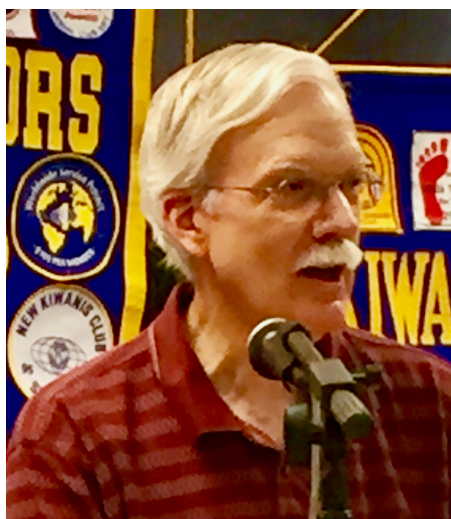

Today's KOD was **Greg Barrick**. Greg remembers hearing about Kiwanis at a graveside service back in the mid 70's. Greg was a funeral director for over 40 years. The Barrick funeral home recently closed and Greg is enjoying his retirement and looking forward to new challenges.

He joined Salem Kiwanis in 1978. Over the years he has held every position in the club from President on down. He is currently club treasurer.

Greg is married to Llynore and they have two children a daughter and a son.

Our program today was presented by **Roberta Moore** who is board chair with **Congregations Helping People**, an expanding group of 18 Salem churches that have come together to combine resources and work cooperatively to help people in need. People seeking help are often forced to go from church to church, obtaining piecemeal aid they need.

Church staff, though eager to help, may not have the time, funds or expertise to provide the best possible help and advice. CHP provides experienced, qualified social workers assisted by caring volunteers, to link people with the right resources to address their immediate and long-term needs. When those resources do not exist, or the person doesn't qualify, CHP may be able to provide direct assistance.

Congregations Helping People is a privately-funded, nonprofit organization governed by a volunteer board of directors, one employee and has a core group of eight volunteers.

Ray said the Boise Kiwanis club has some 30 members who come to most meetings. Members pay all costs, including meals and all dues at a monthly rate of \$60 per month.
